

## BELT SIZING INSTRUCTIONS

Of all the merchandise sold in clothing stores, belts are the most returned items due to sizing issues. Many people will try on shirts and jeans, but will grab a belt from the rack 'cause it looked cool and buy it without trying it on.

When buying a belt, it is important to select the correct size based upon an accurate measurement. Your belt size is not the same as your pant or waist size; because your belt goes around you and your pants, your tucked in shirt, and your underwear, your belt size is usually 1 or 2 inches larger than your pant or waist size. The leading manufacturers of quality belts share the same standard for measuring and labeling belt sizes.

When measuring for a new belt Ladies, please consider how it will be worn.

(1) At your natural waist line with dress pants maybe or

(2) 2"- 3" below the waist with your favorite low-cut jeans.

**Plan A:** This measure is based upon the length of the belt strap only, and does not include the buckle.

For exact sizing purposes, please take a belt you own and measure the distance from the buckle end to the **hole** you are using today  
Do not include the buckle itself



To determine your belt size, follow the guidelines below:

**Plan B:** A regular belt with one of our buckles should be one size (2") larger than your pants. If you wear 34" pants, buy a 36" belt. This allows for the extra

width that pants add to your waist. A belt is measured from the buckle end of the strap to the middle hole, so a 36" belt should fit a 32" to 36" waist with pants. And one more tip. If you're trying on a belt, loop it through your belt loops and buckle it up. If you just wrap it around your waist, you'll get the wrong size.

Custom Buckles: If you're adding a custom buckle to the belt strap, the buckle could add up to 2" to the length of the belt. Measure your buckle (from the catch to the strap end of the buckle). If this is the case, get a belt strap close to your actual waist size.
